



Virus Control Protocol

For All Visitors

Please Stop and Get Your Temperature Checked!

- Visitors who have returned from any country/area which is deemed at RISK in the RKI list within the last 10 days should NOT come into the ISB building without firstly quarantining for 10 days and providing proof of a negative COVID-19 test carried out by the German authorities.
 - 2. The School holds the right to take your temperature and refuse entry based on the results.
 - 3. Any visitor with symptoms of a respiratory illness, a dry cough, sore throat or sudden loss of taste or smell should not come into School.
 - 4. If you have had symptoms of a <u>fever of 37.5 degrees or above</u>, diarrhoea or vomiting it must have passed for 48 hours before coming into School.
 - 5. All visitors should wear medical masks (either surgical/FFP2 or KN95) when in the carpark or school building, at all times.
 - 6. We expect the use of frequent hand washing and the use of our antibacterial hand rub stations. These are positioned in numerous locations around the school with clear signage.
 - 7. Please observe the social distancing rule of 2 meters.
 - 8. Please contain coughs and sneezes on a bent elbow and dispose of any tissues immediately before washing hands.
 - 9. Visitors are asked to undergo a temperature check when entering the building at one of the temperature tablets located in the Foyer or side door.
